Population and Housing Census
May 26, 2001

Population and Housing Census in the Slovak Republic have been conducted in May 2001 according to the Act on 2001 Population and Housing Census No. 165/1998 of the Code.

This Census was a part of a worldwide census, and it was conducted for the first time after the foundation of the Slovak Republic.

During the Population and Housing Census selected demographic, social and cultural characteristics of population, selected data on dwellings and houses and data on household equipment were collected by self-enumeration method.

The content of the Census was designed in terms of international recommendations and the results are internationally comparable.

In comparison with previous Census conducted in 1991, the number of Slovak population increased by 105 thousand (by 2 %), while the number of women increased faster.

The number of economically active persons increased by 48 thousand. Their share in the total population remained unchanged - they represent almost the half of the total Slovak population. The share of women in economically active population increased from 46,9 % in 1991 to the value of 47,7 %.

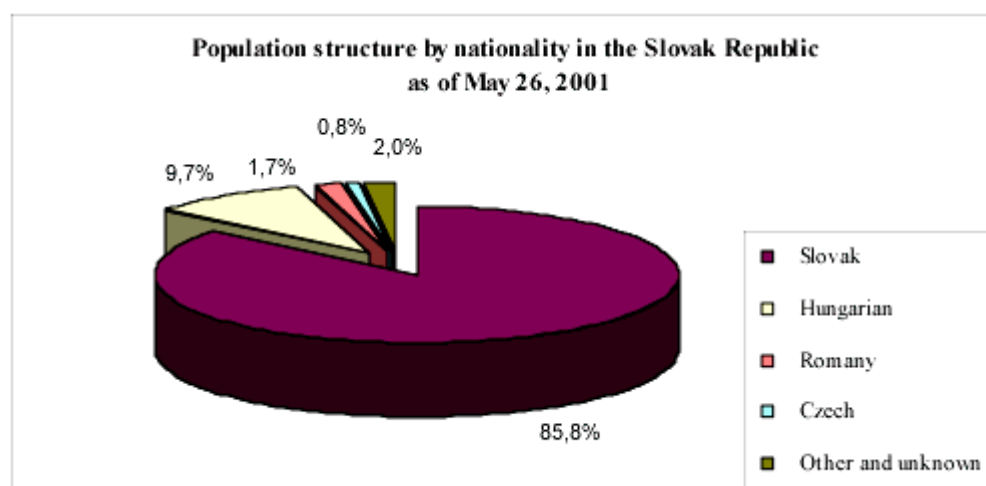

The process of aging of the population continued as the age structure is concerned.

In comparison with 1991, the number of persons in pre-productive age declined by 298 thousand and reached the number of 1 015 thousand persons. The number of persons in productive age increased by 303 thousand and reached the number of 3 349 thousand persons, of which 48 % were women. From the population in post-productive age (967 thousand persons) the share of women was 66,1 %.

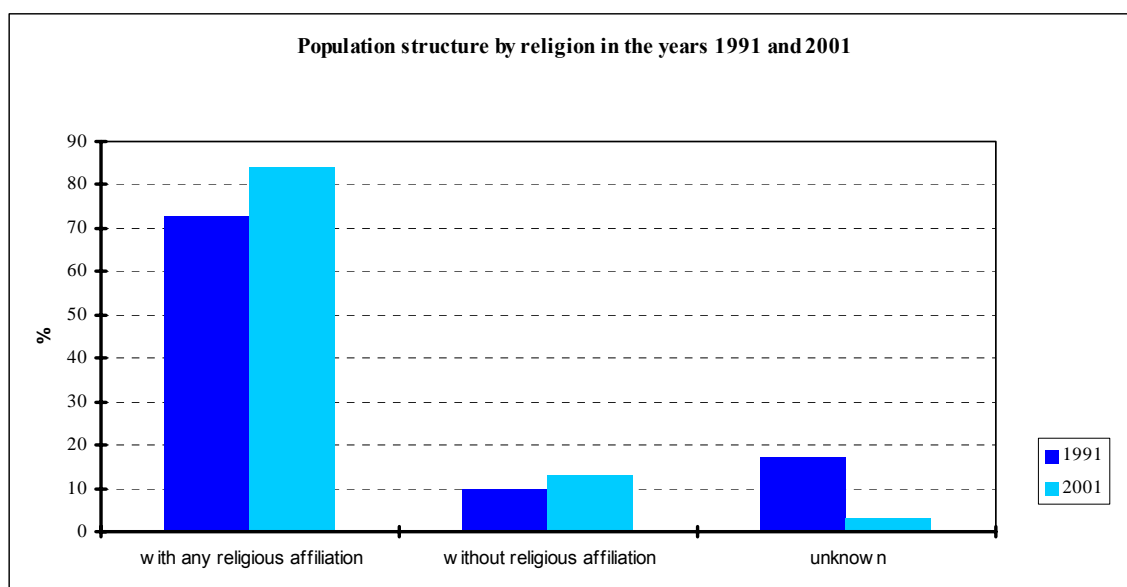

In comparison with 1991, the share of persons with any religious affiliation in total population increased from 72,8 % to 84,1 %.

The share of persons reporting the Roman-Catholic Church increased from 60,4 % in 1991 to 68,9 %, that of persons reporting the Evangelic Church of Augsburg Affiliation increased from 6,2 % to 6,9 %, that of persons reporting the Greek-Catholic Church increased from 3,4 % to 4,1 % and that of persons reporting the Reformed Christian Church increased from 1,6 % to 2 %.

Population structure by religion in the years 1991 and 2001



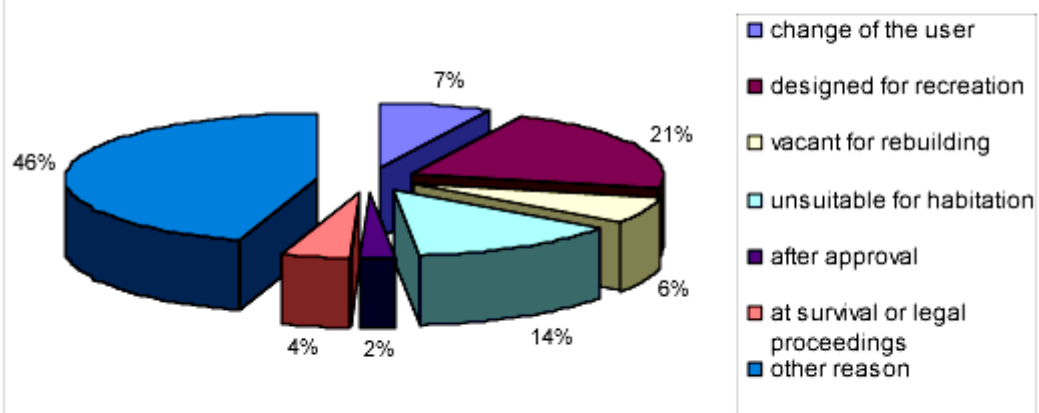

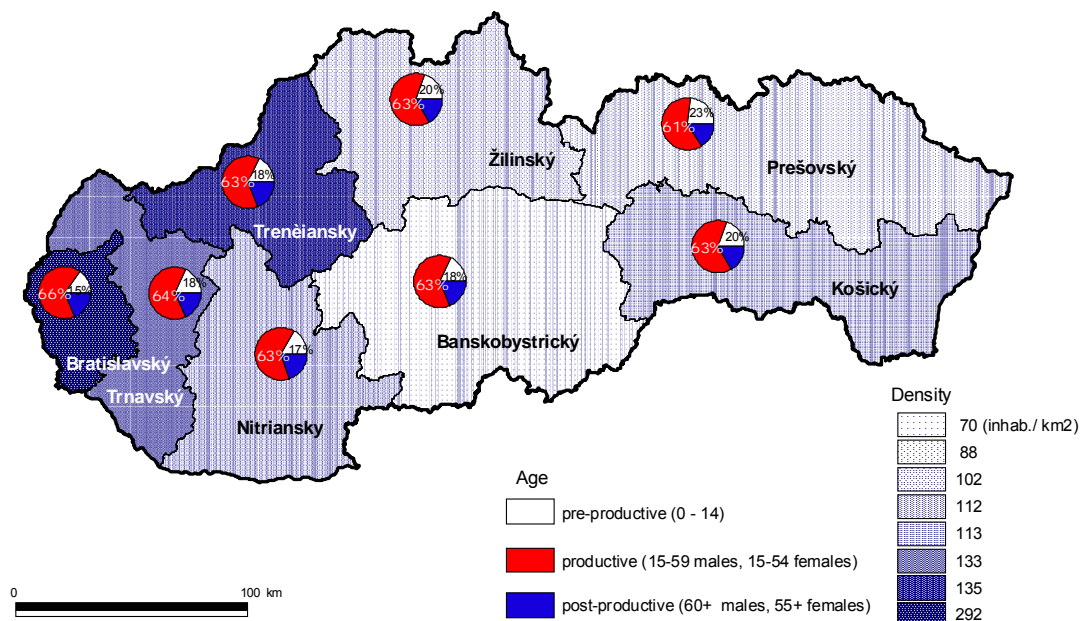
